

Speaker 1: It really depends on your income. The highest bracket with New York State is about 8.85%, a little less than nine, and the highest bracket for New York City income taxes, residency taxes, little less than 4%. You combine those together, you're looking at easily 12-13%. Really just take 12-13% times your income times, of course, penalties and interests, I mean you're not looking at chum change. You're looking at some serious dollars, you know. We've seen bills in excess of six figures from the state and city for sure.
